Mayor Dotson read a municipal order pertaining to inclement weather. A motion was made by Henton, seconded by Carr to approve. All agreed. Motion carried.

Mayor Dotson mentioned that she has had calls regarding individuals doing business out of their homes and not paying business license. All the council agreed to pursue these locations when the city is made aware.

Mayor Dotson reviewed the current animal ordinance pertaining to poultry. Farley said he has had a few people asking to have chickens in city limits. Jestes, Henton and Carr all voiced they are not for amending the current ordinance to allow this.
